

Preschool and Kindergarten Dress Code

The Preschool and Kindergarten Dress Code reflects the Salesian spirit of our school. Our goal is to instill in all Mount Aviat students the respect of self and others through appropriate dress each day. Please note that some restrictions listed below are for the safety of the children while at school.

Shoes

- Children should wear sturdy gym sneakers that tie or fasten with velcro.

Clothing

Girls

- Dresses, skirts, jumpers, and nice play clothing should be worn to school. All shirts and dresses must have sleeves and cover the stomach. Dresses and skirts should be a modest length.
- No hoods on indoor clothing are permitted.
- Shirts and pants may have age-appropriate pictures and logos; however, apparel with writing and/or logos across the bottom are not permitted. Skull designs would not be considered age appropriate.
- Leggings are not considered pants and are not permitted in school.
- Jeans may only be worn on gym days; jeans are not permitted the other days.

Boys

- Shirts, pants, and nice play clothing should be worn to school.
- Shirts and pants may have age-appropriate pictures and logos. Skull designs would not be considered age appropriate.
- No hoods on indoor clothing are permitted
- Jeans may only be worn on gym days; jeans are not permitted on other days.

Jewelry

Girls may wear one pair of small post earrings. Earrings should not be hoops or dangle. Religious medals may be worn. Play and costume jewelry, wristbands, ankle bands, or tattoos may not be worn in school.
