1. **Read the book** listed below and be prepared to take a test at the start of the school year.

Rising grade 2: *The Story of Ferdinand* by Munro Leaf

Rising grade 3: *Freckle Juice* by Judy Blume

Rising grade 4: *Shiloh* by Phyllis Reynolds Naylor (Please bring your novel into school.)

Rising grade 5: *Mrs. Frisby and the Rats of NIMH* by Robert C. O'Brien

Rising grade 6: *Wonder* by R.J. Palacio

Rising grade 7: *Crash* by Jerry Spinelli

Rising grade 8: *Red Badge of Courage* by Stephen Crane (Please bring your novel into school.)

2. **ELA - ReadWorks** Readworks experts have curated a summer reading program that is easy, knowledge-based, and fun. MAA has assigned **15 passages with a few comprehension questions** for students that need to be completed between June 13th August 26th.

Step 1 Go to www.readworks.org/student Sign in with your school Google account.

Step 2 Enter your class code based on your grade in the fall.

Step 3 Start your assignments. Read the passage and answer the comprehension questions.

3. **MATH - Zearn Summer Intensive Series - Rising grades 2 to 7** provides curated content to help kids catch-up and move forward with their learning. Each series is based on data from billions of problems completed on Zearn and designed to accelerate learning for the 22-23 academic year.

Step 1 Go to www.zearn.org Click **Sign In with Google**

Step 2 Enter your Mount Aviat Google username and password.

Each lesson should take 30 minutes.

Students entering grades 2nd (1 Mission), **3rd** (1 Mission) and **4th** (2 Missions) should complete the series. **Students entering grades 5th** (2 Missions), **6th** (2 Missions), and **7th** (3 Missions) must complete at least **35 lessons**.

Students should have a notebook to work out problems. For some activities, there are **Notes** which need to be printed for grades 2 to 6. The 7th graders will only need a notebook. Unless your child has strong math skills, he or she should complete the series. It will provide a solid foundation for the new school year.

Students who struggle in math should work through the series with the support of a tutor or parent. The lessons have been developed and recorded by professional educators, so even a high school student could serve as a tutor by helping your child work through the lessons.

NOTE for Rising 8th Graders:

8th Grade Math Group - Use directions above to log into Zearn.org. **Students must complete 35 lessons**. In order to be well-prepared, they should complete the entire Summer Intensive Series (44 lessons). In addition, it is recommended that all students complete their current ALEKS course (7th Grade Math) to at least 85% to ensure all skills needed for success in 8th grade math are mastered. Algebra Group - Log into Google Classroom (Algebra 1 - Summer Work) and your Math Summer Learning Class will provide all the details you need to complete the summer learning project.
