STUDENTS entering GRADES 2 to 5 - MATH and READING

Summer learning will be through eSpark, an online learning platform that offers differentiated, standardsaligned, math and reading lessons or "Quests". Students will benefit from an hour a week in math and in reading (two or three 20 to 30-minute sessions a week). **Students should complete a minimum of 6-hours of reading and 6-hours of math by August 22nd.** Additional content is available if you want to your child to complete more Quests. STUDENTS entering GRADES 6 to 8 – MATH

Zearn Summer Intensive Series provides curated content to help kids catch-up and move forward with their learning. Each series is designed to accelerate learning for the 2025-26 academic year by reinforcing key concepts from the prior school year. Students entering grades 6 to 8 will complete 35 lessons in the Missions listed below.

Step 3 Refer to the list below to find the Mission(s) assigned to your grade level. All students Grade 6 – G5 Missions 3 and 4 Grade Level Grade 7 – G6 Missions 3, 4 and 5 Accelerated Math Grade 7 – G7 Missions 4, 5, 6 Grade Level 8th – G7 Missions 4, 5, 6 Accelerated Math 8th – G8 Missions 3, 4, 5

Students should have a notebook to work out problems. For some activities, there are **Notes** which need to be printed. **Students who struggle in math** can work through the series with the support of a tutor or parent. The lessons have been developed and recorded by professional educators, so even a high school student could serve as a tutor by helping your child work through the lessons.

STUDENTS entering GRADES 6 to 8 – READING

Summer reading is critical to a student's ability to not only retain information learned the previous year, but also to grow in knowledge and critical thinking for the coming year. Literacy experts believe that it is necessary for students to read daily in order to maintain literacy skills learned in the previous school year.

Students entering grades 6 to 8 will read a minimum of two books, in addition to the summer book assigned to the class. Students log into **Google Classroom** and join **2025 Summer Learning** (Class Code: wu2a7she). All guidelines and directions are included under Classwork. Deadline to submit the Reading Log is August 22, 2025.
