## Mount Aviat Academy Athletic Association Athletic Eligibility Policy

The Mount Aviat Academy Athletic Association offers a sports program designed to encourage the student's total development. It is vital that students who participate in the program maintain an acceptable level of academic achievement. Accordingly, this athletic eligibility policy has been established.

## For the upper school

Any student who receives a deficiency at mid-trimester will be suspended from practicing and playing sports for two weeks (14 days) starting no later than the first Monday following the receipt of the notice (the date as defined by the school calendar). At the discretion of the parent and after parental review of the Friday folder, the student may resume participation if sufficient progress has been achieved. Parents may consult with teachers to determine student progress.

Any student who receives a D+ or I or lower on a report card in any subject area will be suspended from practicing and playing sports for three weeks (21 days) starting no later than the first Monday following the receipt of the report card (the date as defined by the school calendar).

The final report card of the year will impact the eligibility of girls to play volleyball the following fall. Suspension from playing will only apply once school is in session.

## For the lower school

Any student who receives a deficiency notice during the trimester will be suspended from practicing and playing sports for one week (7 days) for each deficiency. The suspension begins no later than the first Monday following the receipt of the notice (the date as defined by the school calendar). At the discretion of the parent and after parental review of the Friday folder, the student may resume participation if sufficient progress has been achieved. Parents may consult with teachers to determine student progress.

Any student who receives and "I" or "U" on a report card in any subject area will be suspended from practicing and playing sports for one week (7 days) for each "I" and "U" earned starting no later than the first Monday following the receipt of the report card (the date as defined by the school calendar).

In addition to the academic requirement, students must display responsible behavior in school. Any student who has accumulated 10 demerits, has been suspended from school, or has received a discipline notice will not be permitted to participate in the sports program for the length of time deemed appropriate by the School Administration. The Administration of the school will review individual cases and decide upon a course of action in particular situations.
